

# Ohio Domestic Violence Fatalities

JULY 1, 2024 - JUNE 30, 2025



For the tenth year, the Ohio Domestic Violence Network has compiled the numbers from media reports of intimate partner relationship fatalities identified by staff and member programs. The count includes targeted victims, perpetrators, and others who were present when the fatalities occurred.


# **157 FATALITIES IN 108 CASES**



### **Deaths from Domestic Violence**

This year, the domestic violence-related deaths of males exceeded deaths of females.


